Republic of Macedonia

- Small, landlocked country of 2 mil. population
- Region troubled by interethnic conflicts during the past years
- Weak economy, poorly maintained infrastructure, impoverished people







Poverty update

- GDP per capita US\$
 2,900; average salary
 US\$ 380 per month
- 36% unemployed,
 28% live below the
 national poverty line
- 40% consider themselves as poor







Poverty housing

- 1990 to date: new constructions per 1000 inhabitants dropped from 5 to 1.6 units
- 110,000 homes (16% of the existing housing stock) need immediate reconstruction, due to unsafe construction, poor maintenance and lack of sanitation







HFH Macedonia











- Non governmental, not-for-profit association established in 2004
- Focus on sustainable housing microfinance models developed as partnerships with entities sharing similar mission and vision






Developing partnership



New Builds

- Traditional Habitat program that brings visibility and recognition
- First project in Veles: 90 homes in 11 buildings, total of 4698 m2 in three years







WSS pilot project


- Households' connection to newly developed public water supply and sanitation networks
- In partnership with local governments
- Project initially implemented in three communities, scaling up expected during FY2010

Challenges HIF, RHF, WSS

- Mission alignment
- Developing sustainable non-financial services (Habitat component)
- Not suitable for GV hosting
- Conflicting interest of the partners: creditworthy vs. needy
- Dualism in measuring outputs: loans disbursed vs. reconstructions completed
- Misuse of loans, definition and sanctions?
- Software synchronization with MFIs?





Challenges NBV

- Planning/budgeting vs. affordable long-term financing
- Harmonizing the interests of volunteers and sub-contractors
- Harmonizing CTW initiative with the ongoing project
- Continuing changes in the legislation
- Software that tracks payment schedules (repayments due)?
- Future new builds?





Challenges Finance & HR

- Variety of programs/projects, models and entities
- Partner's contribution to joint funds invisible in financial reports and program/costs ratios
- Strong dependence on US\$, policies of reallocating the funds available due to US\$ fall?
- Standardizing the Monthly report?
- Lack of qualified professionals
- •Non-financial compensation/benefits?
